New Business

- (1) The Conservancy District was discussed, hoping to hear the final decision within 60 days.
- (2) The State Highway Commission would like to upgrade the R.R. crossings. A motion was made by Mr. Headley, and agreed upon by the Board, to approve the program.
- (3) Jeff McCann asked about annexing the surrounding lake areas. There was some discussion and it was decided to get a petition to see how many people would be in favor.

- (5) Leighton Fritz mentioned a government program, C.E.T.A., in which the Town would hire a person to mow grass etc. It is to be investigated.
- (6) The lighting of Gnagy Park will not be paid for this year because of a shortage of funds.
- (7) There was discussion pertaining to the street of Brookside Park, however, no decision was made.
- (8) Signing of Claims - Claims presented were reviewed and discussed. Warrants were ordered drawn in payment of those claims which had been approved.
