New Business

John Strouse was at the board meeting to discuss the road conditions out at Terry Lake. He informed the Board that mail and bus services will be stopped as of August 15th, 1977, due to the poor conditions of the road. EDA orally said it would be correct to the the excess money for repairing and repaving the roads at Terry Lake (Money from the Water Project), but the EDA will not accept proposal to extend beyond the city limits.

Solicitors: As long as the produce sellers are off the street they can continue with their business.

701 Funding - Comprehensive Plan for the Town was requested by the Chamber of Commerce. \$7500.00 total cost, \$5,000.00 from Federal Monies, and \$2,500.00 in kind service provided by the Hamilton Chamber of Commerce.

Brad Thomas will contact Chuck Howard about the lease for the old city dump. If this can be agreed upon Jim Crowl will clean up the property and seed, with money for the undertaking coming from CCI.

57% of the distribution for the Water System is done.

Met with the Cemetery Board (Fred Fee, Gaylor Drain, Marion Dirrim), they were requesting the street on the West side of the Church not be closed.

The only way this can be done is to contact the Planning Commission of Steuben County. An attorney for the new minister has asked to vacate street west of the church near the cemetery.

The board chose Ceramic Blue as the water tower color. Water plant brick color number 48. Also book case, desk and chairs at the treatment plant were chosen.

There being no further business the meeting was adjourned.
