- (6) A motion was made by Mr. Fritz and seconded by Mr. Heller to accept Mr. Mike Hantz as deputy for the Town of Hamilton.
- (7) Susan Crawl raised the question of providing gas for the Marshal. It was decided to wait until January 1, 1976, so the new board could decide what they wanted to do.
- (8) A motion was made by Mr. Fritz and seconded by Mr. Headley to grade and gravel Oak Street.
