Reading of the Minutes of August 7, 1975, were read by Clerk-Treasurer. There being no additions or corrections, the Minutes stood approved as read.

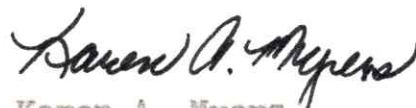
Old Business - None
