Reading of the Minutes

Minutes of the meeting of March 1, 1971 were read by the Clerk-Treasurer. There being no additions or corrections the Minutes stood as read.

New Business

(1) Signing of Claims. Claims presented were reviewed and discussed. Warrants were ordered drawn in payment of claims which were approved.

(2) Law Enforcement.

- (a) Mr Edward Lyons, 309½ North Broadway, Butler, Indiana, introduced himself as an applicant for the job of Town Marshal. Although he did not specify a minimum acceptable wage he did say that he would not consider the job for \$300.00 per month, especially if he had to use his own car and pay for his own gasoline.
- (b) Mr Robert J Zephyr and Mr Ronnie DeWaune Deetz introduced themselves as applicants for the job of Town Marshal and or Deputy Marshal(s). They stated that they would do the job for a combined salary of \$300.00 per month and that that would include the use of their own car and gasoline.
- (c) Reverend Everett Mart and Reverend Amos L McGinnis expressed their concern about the Town Board having adequate law enforcement.
- (g) Having discussed the applicants qualifications and listened

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to the comments of interested individuals at the meeting it was decided to withhold decision and action on the matter until a later date.

(3) Sanitary Land Fill.

- (a) Mr Cardinal Wolff of Wolff Tractor Sales, Edon, Ohio, offered the Town a dozer on a lease basis. The machine involved had already been brought to the Sanitary Landfill for examination.
- (b) Mr Paul S. Swift advised the Board that the County Commissioners were planning a 3 landfill setup within the County, and that the Town's Landfill might qualify as 1 of the 3. Mr. Swift was asked to cover over the bottom of the Landfill as soon as possible and he agreed to do so.
- (c) Lyle Sutton suggested that action be withheld pending official contact with the County Commissioners. Mr Wolff was informed that we would advise him as to the Board's decision on his proposed lease arrangement.

Adjournment. There being no further business to be brought before the Board of Town Trustees the meeting adjourned at 10:15PM.
