- (6) Bids are to be taken for repair of North Miller St. and for construction of offices in the Fire Station for Marshal, Fire Chief, and Clerk-Treasurer.
- (7) Karen A. Myers, Clerk-Treasurer, gave the Board her resignation. Reason: Moving out of the limits of Hamilton.
