Minutes of the Meeting of August 2, 1971

The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Town Trustees was called to order at 7:30PM Monday, August 2, 1971 at The Hamilton Bank. Lyle Sutton presided.

Reading of the Minutes

Minutes of the meeting of July 12, 1971 were read by the Clerk-Treasurer. There being no additions or corrections the minutes stood as read.

Old Business.

(1) The Clerk-Treasurer stated that he had sent a letter to Indiana Equipment Company, Inc. giving them written permission to pick up the bulldozer they had delivered for a test, and releasing them from any liability in so removing it.

New Business

(1) Signing of Claims. Claims presented were reviewed and discussed. Warrants were ordered drawn in payment of claims that were approved.

(2) Insurance on Bulldozer/Back Hoe. It was decided that insurance should be obtained from Heston Insurance, and that we should look into the matter of having workmen's compensation, etc. for the equipment operator and men engaged in pickup and hauling of garbage and trash.

(3) Cutting of Weeds. The Clerk-Treasurer was instructed to send letters to Larry Radcliff and Mary Helen Cameron to have their weeds cut down.

(4) Citizen Complaints on Streets & Erosion.

(a) Mr Robert Hamman asked the Board to check the holes in the street by his residence and have them repaired.

(b) Mr & Mrs Jack Davis asked the Board to check the street, sidewalk, parking, and erosion of soil by their residence.

(5) Street Repair. On motion of Walter Heller, seconded by Paul Headley and carried, the Clerk-Treasurer was instructed to call Reith-Riley Company to have three (3) truck loads of cold mix delivered and placed at designated locations. Mr Dirrim is to fill in pot-holes and other places needing fill. This action is in lieu of any major street resurfacing this year due to budgetary limitations and the possibility of starting construction on the sewer system next year.

Adjournment. There being no further business to be conducted the meeting was adjourned at 9:30 PM.
