Reading of the Minutes

Minutes of the meeting of July 6, 1970 were read by the Clerk-Treasurer. There being no additions or corrections the Minutes were approved as read.

New Business

- (1) Review of Claims. Claims were reviewed and signed by the Trustees. Warrants were ordered drawn in payment of same.
- (2) Traffic Complaint. Mr Ross B Mortorff asked for assistance in reducing the incidents of speeding past his home on Belfountain Road. Mr Deetz said he would give this matter additional attention.
- (3) Lyle Sutton stated he had received a complaint about the high grass and weeds on the Bill Boyer property located behind Gaylord Crain residence. The Clerk-Treasurer was requested to send a letter to Mr Boyer asking that he cut the grass and weeds promptly.
- (4) State Board of Health Letter on Open Dumps. Lyle Sutton read a letter from the State Board of Health dated July 30, 1970 requesting written advice of actions taken to comply with the Refuse Disposal Act, Section 30, of 1969. The Clerk-Treasurer was asked to answer the letter.
- (5) Review of 1971 Budget. A discussion was held regarding the proposed budget for calendar year 1971. It was decided that an application would be submitted for an additional appropriation of \$4,050.00 in the MVH Fund. A special meeting was set for Monday August 24, 1970 to hear any taxpayers who wished to be heard thereon, and that the regular budget meeting would be held August 31, 1970 as required by the State Board of Tax Commissioners.

(6) Law Enforcement. A lengthy discussion was held with Mr Deetz and Mr Zephyr regarding law enforcement activities. The Clerk-Treasurer was asked to obtain Traffic Warning Tickets as soon as possible.

(7) Adoption of Ordinance. The attached Ordinance was discussed at length. A motion was made by Lyle Sutton, seconded by Paul Headley and carried that subject Ordinance be adopted.

Adjournment. There being no further business to come before the Board the meeting adjourned at 10:30PM.
