Reading of the Minutes

Minutes of the meeting of November 1, 1971 were read by the Clerk-Treasurer. There being no additions or corrections the Minutes stood as read.

Old Business

(1) Town Sanitary Landfill. Steve Swift stated that he had finished bulldozing at the landfill, and that he had delivered six (6) load of gravel to improve access. He presented a claim in the amount of \$345.00 which was approved for payment. He also informed the Trustees that a State Inspector was at the landfill the day he finished bulldozing and that he expressed satisfaction.

New Business

(1) Law Enforcement. Mr Ronnie DeWayne Deetz submitted his monthly activity report. He asked about guidelines for snowmobiles and was advised that insolfar as County Roads are concerned such guidelines will be established by the County Commissioners.

(2) Hauling of Garbage & Trash. Bazil Penland stated that a dog had prevented trash pickup at Lansford's place. He submitted a bill for thirty (30) hours work @ \$2.00 per hour, for work on town streets. Payment was approved.

(3) Signing of Claims. Claims presented were reviewed and discussed. Warrants were ordered drawn in payment of claims that were approved.
