Minutes of the Meeting of February 2, 1970

The meeting was called to order at 7:45 Monday February 2, 1970 at the Town Hall. Lyle Sutton presided.

Reading of the Minutes: Minutes of the meeting of January 5, 1970 were read. There being no additions or corrections the minutes were accepted as read.

Old Business: The Clerk-Treasurer stated that the Annual Financial Statement had been published in two (2) newspapers and that a certified copy of same had been submitted to the State Board of Accounts as required by law.

New Business:

1. The Status of Funds report was reviewed and discussed at length. It was decided that purchases by the Volunteer Fire Department would not be paid from Town funds unless authority had been given by the Board of Town Trustees in advance. The purchase of gasoline, oil and routine vehicle maintenance for Fire Department equipment were exempted from this ruling.

2. Activity reports are to be submitted each month by the Marshal and Deputy Marshal.

3. The Fire Department was authorized by the Board to obtain repairs on the Fire Whistle which is inoperative.

There being no further business the meeting adjourned at 8:45PM.
