Mr. Brad Thomas, President of the Board of Town Trustees, and Mr. Ron Burch, Fire Chief, Hamilton Volunteer Fire Department, are to discuss a solution with Mr. McIntosh.
- (4) A motion was made by Dennis Fee, and seconded by Susan Crawl, to start action on offices to be located in the Fire Department for Fire Chief, Marshal, and Clerk-Treasurer.
- (5) Mr. Ed Sanxter spoke with Dennis Fee concerning a catch basin in front of Mr. Ron Hellers' property. Drainage is also a problem there.
- (6) It was motioned by Susan Crawl, and seconded by Brad Thomas to give the Marshal \$50 monthly for gasoline for his truck.

- (8) More applications are to be taken for the position of deputy.
- (9) Mr. Carl Akers made a request for city water, and to help re-enact the Chamber of Commerce.
- (10) Mr. Bob Everitts reported that the Tone Alert is now ready for use. All fire call will now go through the Sheriffs' Office before being dispatched to the Fire Department.
