READING OF THE MINUTES

Reading of the Minutes for June 7, 1976, were read by the Clerk-Treasurer. There being no additions or corrections, the Minutes stood approved as read.

OLD BUSINESS

The Town Board came to the decesion that the Town was not committed in any way to the ~~maintenance~~ of the Terry Lake roads. Research was made of the past minutes and we could find where there was any promises made by the past Town Board in regards to the Terry Lake roads.
