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Minutes of the Meeting of June 1, 1970

The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Town Trustees was called to order at 7:30 PM Monday, June 1, 1970 in the basement of the Hamilton Bank. Lyle Sutton presided.

Reading of the Minutes

Minutes of the regular monthly meeting of May 4, 1970 were read. There being no additions or corrections the Minutes were accepted as read.

Minutes of the special meeting of June 11, 1970 were read. Under the heading "Persons Present" the names of Arvin Elickenstaff and Lyle Armstrong are to be added. There being no other additions or corrections the balance of the Minutes were accepted as read.

Old Business

- (1) Street Lighting in Newly Annexed Areas. Indiana & Michigan Electric Company has not furnished cost estimates for new lighting in the annexed areas.
- (2) Bids for Resurfacing & Repair of Streets. A representative of Reith, Riley & Company has offered to meet with the Board of Town Trustees on Saturday, June 6, 1970 to clarify bid costs.

New Business

- (1) Removal of Garbage & Trash. Motion was made by Paul Headley, seconded by Walter Heller and passed that Mr Lloyd Weinhold be hired at a salary of \$2,400.00 per annum. Garbage and trash is to be removed from residences once each week and from business establishments twice each week within the incorporated limits of Hamilton.

- (2) Annexation of the Lakewood Development Area. Lyle Sutton asked Steve Swift to furnish the DeKalb County Auditor a map of the lakewood development area, showing acreage and boundaries, and also to furnish the DeKalb County Recorder with a copy of Ordance 110 to be filed. Steve Swift agreed to take care of both items.

Paul Headley asked that the Board of Town Trustees be furnished with a set of the rules and regulations for Lakewood Development.

- (3) Town Sanitary Land Fill. The Clerk-Treasurer was instructed to insert another notice in The Hamilton News as to the days and hours of operation of the town sanitary land fill.
- (4) Construction of a Public Boat Launching Ramp and Dock. Motion was made by Walter Heller, seconded by Paul Headley and passed that the town construct a public boat launching ramp and dock. C. S. Smyth Exsivating Company is to be authorized to build a twenty foot (20') concrete ramp.
- (5) Factory Site. The Clerk-Treasurer was instructed to send a letter to Mr Ben S Patton of Patton Electric Company in Fort Wayne advising him that the Board of Town Trustees will make available the necessary land to build a factory on here at Hamilton. The Chamber of Commerce has been advised of this action.
- (6) Law Enforcement.

Mr Robert J Zephyr was sworn in as a Deputy. Lyle Sutton administered the oath.

Mr Deetz requested the appointment of two (2) more reserve deputies at a future date.

Discassion was held regarding the possibility of appointing a Justice of the Peace for Hamilton.

Mr Deetz requested three (3) pads of traffic tickets, and a Fire Extinguisher. Approval was given to obtain them.

Mr Deetz and Mr Zephyr talked at length about proposed plans for upgrading the law enforcement fuctions of the Town of Hamilton. It was concluded that Mr Harry Dirrim would no longer serve as the Town Marshal. With the concurrence of the Board of Town Trustees Mr Deetz was appointed and accepted the position of Town Marshal.

Activity report for the month was submitted and made a matter of record.

- (7) Review of Claims. Claims were reviewed and approved. Warrants were ordered drawn in payment of those claims which had been approved.
- (8) Review of Status of Town Funds. The status of town funds was reviewed and discussed. The report is attached and made a matter of record.
