Reading of the Minutes

New Business

(1) Signing of Claims. Claims presented were reviewed and discussed. Warrants were ordered drawn in payment of the claims that were approved.

(2) Town Sanitary Land Fill

- a. Indiana Equipment Company. The Clerk-Treasurer was directed to contact the Company by telephone to have their bulldozer picked up at the Land Fill.
- b. Hamilton Community Schools are authorized to dump their trash at the Landfill without charge, so long as they haul it there at no expense to the Town.
- c. Motion was made by Lyle Sutton, seconded by Walter Heller and carried that a new gate be installed at the Land Fill.
- d. Lyle Sutton suggested that a barrel of rat poison be bought for use at the Land Fill. Motion was made by Walter Heller and seconded by Paul Headley that a barrel of rat poison be purchased. Motion carried.

(3) Street Repairs. Motion was made by Paul Headley, seconded by Walter Heller and carried that Gnagy Gravel be authorized to scrape and apply gravel to the alleyways behind Henry Maier and by L D Fifer.
