Reading of the Minutes

Minutes of the Meeting of October 5, 1970 were read. There being no additions or corrections the Minutes stood as read.

Old Business

Lyle Sutton mentioned that the meeting at Pokagon State Park on the spillway and public fishing site had been cancelled. Paul Headley commented on his trip to the Department of Natural Resources hearing on the subject held at the State Office Building in Indianapolis.

Lyle Sutton mentioned that he had a letter from our former Deputy Mr Ronnie DeWayne Deetz in which Mr Deetz stated that his services were still available "on-call" and that his fee for an evening would be approximately \$35.00.

New Business

Hubert Heston discussed corrective actions required by our insurance carrier. It was decided that we would (1) point up the chimney (Paul); (2) apply mortar to the pillars; (3) take corrective action on the beach items in the spring; and (4) Mr Heston would advise his company of these actions and that we are planning to begin construction of a new Fire Station/Town Hall next spring.

Margaret Mathers submitted a letter (attached) in which she asked that a street light be installed at Lake Street and West Mill. No action was taken on the matter other than to accept her letter.

Discussion was held regarding installation of a sidewalk from L D Fifer's place on out to the School. No action was taken.
