Minutes of the Meeting of October 4, 1971

The regular monthly meeting of the Board of Town Trustees was called to order at 7:30PM, Monday, October 4, 1971 at The Hamilton Bank. Lyle Sutton presided.

Reading of the Minutes

Minutes of the regular monthly meeting of September 6, 1971 were read by the Clerk-Treasurer. There being no additions or corrections the Minutes stood as read.

Old Business

- (1) Wolverine Insurance Company. Reference Minutes of September 1971 meeting. The Clerk-Treasurer had called the Manager of the company's Commercial Casualty Department and requested that he attend our October 4, 1971 meeting. He did not attend as agreed.
- (2) Fire Insurance Classifications. Reference Minutes of September 1971 meeting. The Clerk-Treasurer contacted the Indiana Rating Bureau and requested written data on ratings. Five (5) copies were furnished by mail. A copy is attached and made a part of these Minutes.

New Business

- (1) Signing of Claims. Claims presented were reviewed and discussed. Warrants were ordered drawn in payment of claims that were approved.
- (2) Survey & Maintenance of Lake Street. Mr & Mrs Wayne Dirrim requested the Trustees to approve the surveying of Lake Street from the alley on Oak Street to Lake and from Lake Street to the DeKalb County Line, so that the street can be opened and maintained. He (Wayne Dirrim) stated that he and his brother Marion Dirrim will pay for the surveying on a 50-50 basis with the Town of Hamilton. Their request was considered and approved, and they were asked to contact the surveyors as soon as possible.

(3) Intersection of State Road 427 & Bellfountain Road. The Trustees asked Mr Wayne Dirrim to assist in obtaining approval to make the intersection a four-way stop. Mr. Dirrim agreed to help.

(4) Request for Gravel. A discussion was held regarding the condition of the roadside by Kenneth Teegardin and Max Baker homes on Bellfountain Road. The Clerk-Treasurer was instructed to have Gnagy Gravel furnish no more than two (2) loads of gravel along said roadside.

Adjournment. There being no further business to come before the meeting the Trustees adjourned at 9:15PM.
